



## **New Relic FedRAMP Status**

We are happy to announce that New Relic has received FedRAMP authorization for Low Impact SaaS services on December 19, 2019. We are also excited to provide an update on our progress towards achieving authorization for Moderate Impact.

New Relic originally expected to receive FedRAMP Moderate in mid November. But have agreed with the FedRAMP PMO office to re-address one remaining control of the 325 total controls due to a new interpretation of the requirement. For any customer needing the FedRAMP Moderate authorization before end of February 2020, the New Relic security team and FedRAMP PMO office is willing to review the agreed to resolution on the final control to be addressed.

With this path, New Relic reaffirms our commitment to the security of customer data and customer information systems. We hope that our transparency in this matter provides you with confidence in our commitment to our customers and growing maturity as a company. We are on track and expect to receive authorization for Moderate Impact by the end of February 2020.
